


# Warehouse Operative

You will manage goods in and out of the factory, ensuring that all our customers get the right products, well packaged, when they expect it, and that goods received is recorded accurately and stored correctly.

- Experience in a Manufacturing warehouse/stores environment.
- Must be able to work independently and communicate with all levels of the organisation.

- Organisation and time management for working to/within tight timescales.

#### **DESIRABLE SKILLS**

- Use of MRP/ERP (Material Requirements Planning/ Enterprise Resource Planning) within a warehouse/ stores environment.
- Certified Fork Lift Truck holder (Counterbalance) desirable.

### ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES

As a Warehouse Operative at Kensa Heat Pumps, you will work as part of a team to ensure that materials and finished goods flow smoothly into, through and out of the factory.

- Replenishment of shopfloor, in accordance with Kanban system, ensuring that there are no shortages.
- Timely receipt and processing of all materials at goods inwards. Safe and coordinated storage of all materials using FIFO principles to ensure integrity of materials at all times.
- Timely and accurate processing of all goods issued to internal and external customers ensuring FIFO principles are applied.
- Maintaining accurate picking/put away of materials. Participate in cycle-counting and stock audits when required.
- Liaise with production and logistics to agree packing and despatch timelines.
- Packing of all outbound shipments to ensure integrity and protection of product.
- Organisation of areas of work using 5S principles.
- Participate in the ongoing improvement of the systems used within the department in accordance with the requirements of: ISO 9001.
- Maintain the effectiveness of the Quality system at the sites via adherence to applicable policies and procedures.
- Adhere to Environmental, Health and Safety policies and procedures.

#### **WORKBASE**

This role will be based at the Kensa Heat Pumps factory in Truro.

Reporting to the Factory Manager.
